Focus Course Title (4 courses may be selected from the electives listed above)

Focus = Although AMS emphasizes interdisciplinary study, by the end of their senior year students should be able to name an area of focus in which they have taken 4 courses to identify their personalized pathway through the major. As a reference point, previous examples include Popular Culture, Race & Ethnicity, and Museums & Public History, but we emphasize that each student will construct and name their own focus in consultation with their adviser.

Analytic field = Three courses, chosen in consultation with the student's advisor, that engage one or more of the analytic fields found in the major requirements on the AMS webpage or in the course catalog. Students must cover at least three different analytical fields to complete the major.

History / Change over time = One course that studies the past and explores change over time. (such courses can be found in a wide variety of departments including AMS, HST, AFR, ENG, ARH, FMS, & GOV)

Transnational / Diasporic / Global / Comparative Perspective = One course that studies culture and society from a transnational/diasporic/global/comparative perspective.
