Tuition:	Tuition Invoicing sent directly to Smith
Accommodation:	Ros Geal Residence will send invoice directly to Smith Donegan Court will send invoice to student or Smith. Rent will be billed for complete semester. Student should pay for any general maintenance and then submit documentation to Study Abroad Coordinator
Accommodation Expectations:	Apply for University approved residential accommodation - EARLY Students in the past have applied for accommodations in Ros Geal University Residence, Donegan Court, Nilands Limited or in another university approved housing.
Accommodation Application Deadline at National University of Ireland, Galway:	As soon as acceptance is received. Apply for University approved residential accommodation - EARLY
Visa:	All students applying directly to host schools/universities will be required to obtain their own visa. It is very important that students begin this process early, as it may take a several months to obtain. This is especially true for International Students.
